8. How many wooden benches can you count around the churchyards? (don't forget the New Cemetery)
9. In summer, what is the name of the plant that grows on the walls of the path leading up to the porch?

Vetch	White Clover	Hogweed (don't touch)

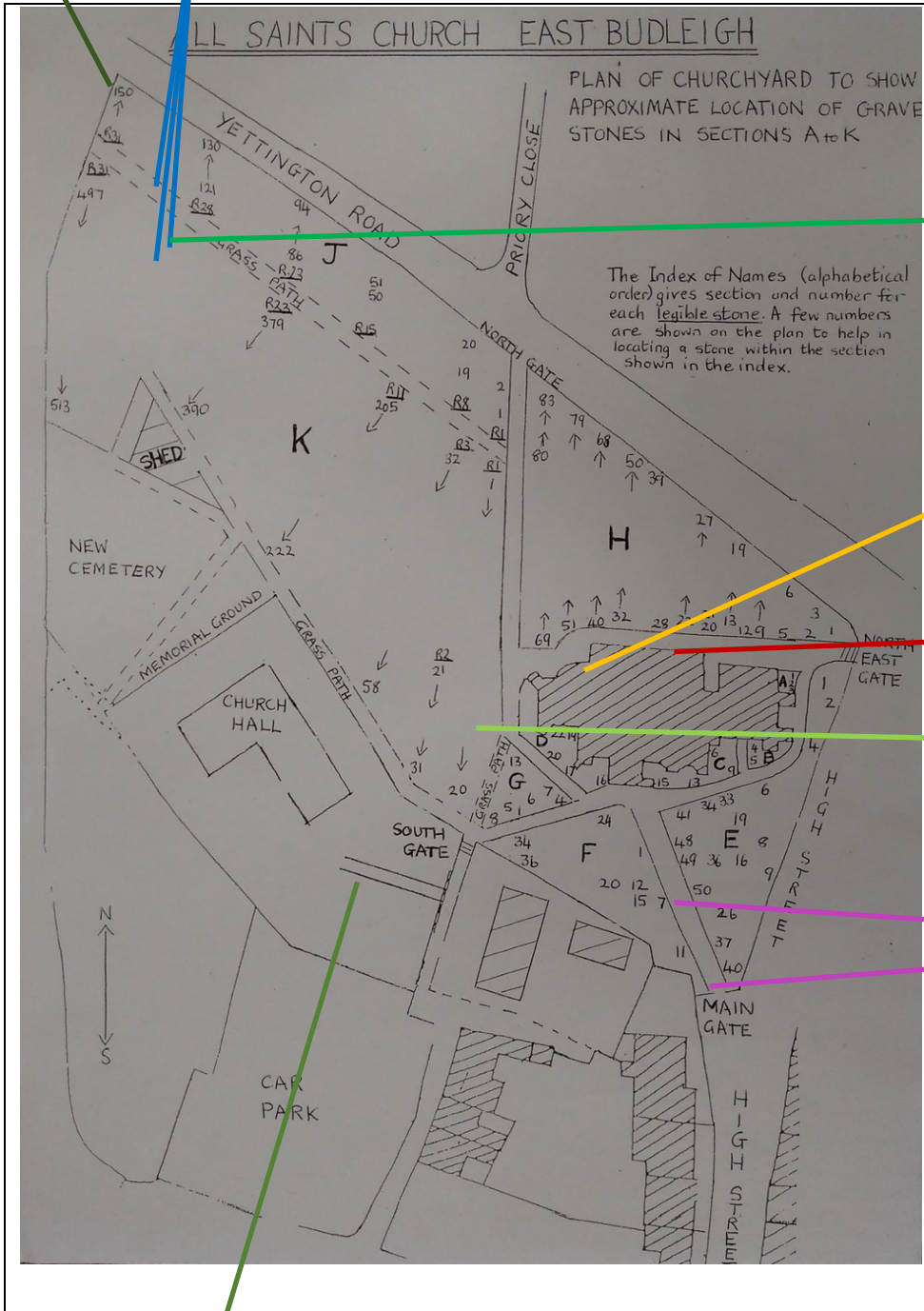
11. Name the animal on top of the weathervane.
