The FoAS help to protect and preserve the fabric of the Church and maintain the Churchyard in good condition. For the community, we also help fund the church floodlights and produce and distribute the Parish News magazine free of charge to all households in the parish.

The FoAS work and fund raising has recently contributed to:

- The grilles to protect the stained glass windows;
- Repairs to the Church clock;
- Tidying a number of graves in 2017 as part of the bicentenary celebration of the birth of former resident Vice Admiral George William Preedy CB (1817-1894) buried in the Churchyard;
- The re-painting and re-gilding of the weathervane;
- Equipment in the Church;
- The repairs to the south-east corner of the Church (to be done in 2018);
- Clearing the access to and areas around the seven War Graves in our Churchyard.

The FoAS organise the monthly 200 Club Raffle, talks, concerts and the annual East Budleigh Scarecrow Festival to raise funds.
