The children are very excited about their upcoming trip to the Pantomime, Beauty and the Beast, and are looking forward to all the other Christmas festivities that we have planned for them.

OCESA (our school's PTFA) have a brand new committee, all of whom are enthusiastic and full of ideas of how to fundraise for our school. They are helping us to fundraise to make improvements to an area of our playground known as 'Sophie's Garden'; this area has long since been dedicated to Sophie, a child who used to attend our school who sadly passed away after a lifelong illness, but is long overdue improvement to make it the special place that it deserves to be. Has LORP made the flooding worse? The flooding in the lower Otter valley this October was a dramatic example of what will happen increasingly as our climate changes. The river rose quickly to levels higher than they have been here in Budleigh for over eight years; levels rose quickly in surrounding valleys too. This flood event was an entirely natural phenomenon and, importantly, was not caused or exacerbated by the Lower Otter Restoration Project works.
