Dear friends,

As inexorably, the Winter changes to Spring, so I hope the dark days of enforced separation from loved ones, fear of disease, lots of premature deaths and severe restrictions on our civil liberties may soon be behind us.

I hope and pray that indeed 2021 is collectively a far kinder and happier time for all of us, and that you will be blessed in your life with the gift of peace.

* Planting trees to replace those suffering from disease, and encouraging the use of the dog poo bins.


