Whist we, of course, hope that nobody will have need, it is worth mentioning that the Village Defibrillator is located on the wall of the Village Hall. It contains instructions for use and can be a life saver (please do advise the Clerk if you have used the device so we can ensure it is maintained).

The Parish Council is also delighted to confirm that after completing a successful planning application, landing lights are to be installed at the Stantyway Recreation Field to enable the Devon Air Ambulance to land safely in darkness - so important for our rural community. Completion of this project has only been possible due to the generosity of some of the businesses in the Village and we are enormously grateful for their support.

During the last COVID outbreak so many residents looked out for their neighbours. It is looking more and more likely that this might once again be necessary - thank you for the many kindnesses you continue to show.
