## View from The Vicarage



Happy New Year!

January is the season of Epiphany in the church, perhaps my favourite season because it captures the sense of excitement about what the Christmas event actually means!

It means that humanity and divinity are not separate after all – and the fullness of life that is promised to us is realised when we fully know that unity – the unity modelled in the life of Jesus Christ.

The story that is used to demonstrate this new way of thinking and being is the story of the water turned into wine. A deeply symbolic story of the marriage feast, representing the final marriage between God and his people, and how the water of our ordinary existence is turned into rich intoxicating wine when God is allowed to suffuse it with His Spirit.

Seeing the importance of signs and symbols and metaphor was what first allowed me to see beyond the surface meaning of John's gospel, and see

deeper into the Christ mystery. It raises the turning of water into wine from what might be seen as a party trick into a symbol of life changing and life enhancing significance.

### **OTTERTON COMMUNITY SHOP**

We have recently received a copy of a letter sent by one community shop chairman to his customers stating that the current economic climate is placing many community stores under enormous pressure and that the very future of their store is in the balance. He wrote:

'Over the last 12 months, the economic picture has changed significantly, and we are now in a very different and very difficult trading environment with inflation impacting many aspects of the business...without an increase in support for the shop, we will not be able to sustain our model.'

He went on to outline the measures taken to reduce costs, the scope of the services and products on offer and advised of reduced opening hours. His final plea:

'So please, please, over the next few weeks show your support for the shop...'

The Otterton Community Shop continues to trade reasonably well but we too are acutely aware that fortunes can change very quickly, so our hope is that your New Year's resolutions will include a commitment to support the shop as much as you can during 2023 and ensure the continuance of what is a vital village asset.
